

The Department of Mathematics at Slippery Rock University is expanding its course offerings in statistics and actuarial mathematics. We also anticipate starting a Master of Science degree program in Big Data Analytics in Fall 2015. In order to accommodate this growth we are expecting to fill the following three tenure-track positions:

The teaching load is 12 credits per semester of undergraduate courses or 9 credits per semester of graduate courses. The successful candidate must have a PhD prior to employment and will be expected to maintain a scholarly agenda. Applicants with prior college-level teaching experience and a history of scholarly achievement are preferred. Competitive salary is commensurate with experience. Full consideration will be given to applications that are completed by 1 December, but the search will continue until the position is filled.
