

## **Central Michigan University Tenure Track Statistics Position**

The Department of Mathematics at Central Michigan University, an innovative doctoral/research-intensive institution recognized for strong undergraduate education and a range of focused graduate programs and research, invites applications for a tenure track position in Statistics at the Assistant Professor level beginning Fall 2016. While all areas of Statistics will be considered, preferences will be given to candidates whose expertise are in the areas of Applied Statistics, Actuarial Science or Data Mining. Candidates are expected to have a Ph.D. in Statistics and to be able to demonstrate excellent verbal and written communication skills, as well as excellence in teaching and research. Applicants must demonstrate the ability to contribute to the department's graduate program in statistics. Expected duties include graduate and undergraduate teaching, sustained research, supervision of graduate students, university and department service, and the submission of competitive external funding proposals.
