



Postdoctoral Research Fellow

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at the University of South Florida invites applications for a postdoctoral research position in Mathematics/Statistics beginning August 7, 2015. The salary is \$39,000, supported by a U.S. Army Research Office grant. This position carries a one-year appointment and may be renewed for up to two additional years depending on satisfactory performance. Preference will be given to candidates who have received their Ph.D. in the Mathematical Sciences within the last three years or will be completing their Ph.D. by the end of Summer 2015. Candidate must have a Ph.D. by the time of appointment, outstanding research record/potential, a desire to work in a stimulating research environment, and a serious interest in the basic research.

Required application materials include: a cover letter; a curriculum vita; a research statement; and at least two letters of recommendation.

Applications must be submitted through the AMS MathJobs website (<https://www.mathjobs.org/jobs?joblist-663-7282>). Review of applications will begin on July 6, 2015, and continue until the position is filled.
