



Faculty Position in Biostatistics

The Department of Biostatistics invites applications for an open rank faculty position (Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor). With the recruitment of a new Dean, Dr. Jasjit S. Ahluwalia, the School is undergoing a rapid expansion. The successful applicant will be expected to develop and sustain an extramurally funded research program; contribute to the teaching mission; and mentor MPH, MS, and doctoral students. The School is recruiting applicants who can support expanded efforts in clinical and translational sciences (CTS) across Rutgers Biomedical and Health Sciences (RBHS). Applicants will participate in the design and conduct of collaborative studies, develop statistical methodology, and conduct research with an aim of obtaining extramural grants. Strong training and a track record in modern multivariate statistical methods, biocomputing, biomedical informatics, and experience in clinical and translational research are essential. The successful applicant will find a wide range of experts within the School of Public Health (sph.rutgers.edu) and Rutgers Biomedical and Health Sciences (RBHS; rbhs.rutgers.edu), including the Cancer Institute of New Jersey (cinj.org), the Institute for Health, Health Care Policy, and Aging Research (ihhpar.rutgers.edu), the Environmental and Occupational Health Sciences Institute (eohsi.rutgers.edu), the Robert Wood Johnson Medical School (rwjms.rutgers.edu), the New Jersey Medical School (njms.rutgers.edu), and the Ernest Mario School of Pharmacy (pharmacy.rutgers.edu). A robust mentoring program is being established within the school for faculty. The School of Public Health is located on the Rutgers University–New Brunswick and RBHS at Newark campuses, and is close to New York City and the beaches of the Atlantic Ocean. An attractive recruitment package will include a competitive salary and start-up funds. The successful applicant will have a doctoral degree (PhD or equivalent), a demonstrated record of peer-reviewed publications, and extramural grant support as appropriate to their faculty rank.
