Candidates with a Master's degree may be considered for appointment at the Visiting Instructor level. Prior teaching experience is required. Teaching load is typically 12-15 contact hours per semester, and typically includes large multi-section lectures and supervision of recitation teaching assistants. Consideration of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position(s) is filled.
