Rank: Assistant or Associate Professor of Applied Statistics.

Description: We are seeking a candidate who will fully contribute to the intellectual activities of the department and provide high quality teaching in the areas of Business Analytics at the undergraduate and graduate levels. Research and teaching interests should be in the areas of big data, predictive analytics, business intelligence, data mining, data management and/or data visualization. It would also be highly desirable for the applicant to have an interest in Management Information Systems. Promotion and tenure depend on the quality of research and teaching.

In addition to its emphasis on research, the Lundquist College targets the development of certain skills in our students and faculty, especially the ability to pursue cross-disciplinary initiatives. Therefore, the ability to engage with one or more interdisciplinary signature centers in the college will be a plus. The successful candidate will have the ability to work effectively with faculty, staff, and students from a variety of diverse backgrounds.

Qualifications: Assistant level: Candidates must have a completed or nearly completed Ph.D. degree in Applied Statistics or related discipline; demonstrated potential for teaching and research excellence. Associate level: Ph.D. degree in Statistics or related area such as econometrics; a record of scholarly accomplishment and demonstrated teaching competence.
