

Assistant Professor, Statistics/Biostatistics

The Department of Mathematics at The College of William & Mary seeks applications for a position at the Assistant Professor level in Statistics, Biostatistics, or related areas. Applicants must hold a Ph.D. in Statistics, Mathematics, or a related field at the time of appointment (August 10, 2015). Candidates should demonstrate excellence in research and teaching. The regular teaching expectation is two courses per semester with most classes capped at 35 students. Previous experience in teaching and mentoring successful undergraduate and/or graduate research is preferred. The site will also ask for the names and email addresses of 3 or more references (at least one concerning teaching).
