While FSU Libraries provide print and online resources for classes, it is also a service point for assisting students with the navigation of those resources, and how to better understand their research question options. Our Librarians offer the following resources for graduate students.

1. Library Express Delivery Service (LEDS), InterLibrary Loan (ILL), and U BORROW
 - ILL and U BORROW is available to all FSU faculty, staff, and students.

2. Course Reserves

Supplemental materials for courses may be placed on course reserve for the semester when the course is offered.

3. Research Consultation Support

Your Statistics Subject Librarian can tailor research consultations for your own research needs. Research consultations are individual meetings that typically last 30 minutes—1 hour to support scholarship.
